#### **REGULAR AGENDA ITEMS**

1. Discussion and possible action on **Ordinance No. 592** authorizing the issuance and sale of the City of Waller, Texas Certificates of Obligation, Series 2022; levying a tax and providing for the security and payment thereof and enacting other provisions relating thereto.

2. Discussion and possible action on updates to Security Disclosure Procedures.

Finance Officer Maryann Carl addressed Council regarding the updates to Security Disclosure Procedures, maintaining and evidencing the City's internal procedures for ensuring compliance with federal and state securities laws, preparing, and reviewing its disclosures in connection with the issuance of debt obligations, and complying with its continuing disclosure obligations, if any, entered into in connection with the issuance of such debt obligations.

Councilmember Nancy Arnold motioned to approve the updates on the Security Disclosure. Mayor Pro Tem Dwayne Hajek seconded the motion. Motion passed.

3. Discussion and possible action to enter into a master equity lease agreement, maintenance agreement, and maintenance management and fleet rental agreement with Enterprise Fleet Management for replacement of four Public Works vehicles.
